### Recent publications from NHS Fife staff: February 2023

This monthly bulletin aims to raise awareness of research activity across NHS Fife.

Core medical/health databases were searched to identify articles where at least one author is a member of staff from NHS Fife. Research activity may have been carried out solely by NHSF staff or in collaboration with colleagues from external institutions. The database search is supplemented by information supplied by the Pure team at St Andrew's University.

Databases searched: Medline, Embase, PsycInfo, Cinahl.

We searched for records added to the databases during February 2023.

We included: articles, conference abstracts, letters.

Where practicable we excluded: errata, corrections, comments, author's responses.

Local authors are highlighted in **yellow** so they can be readily identified.
